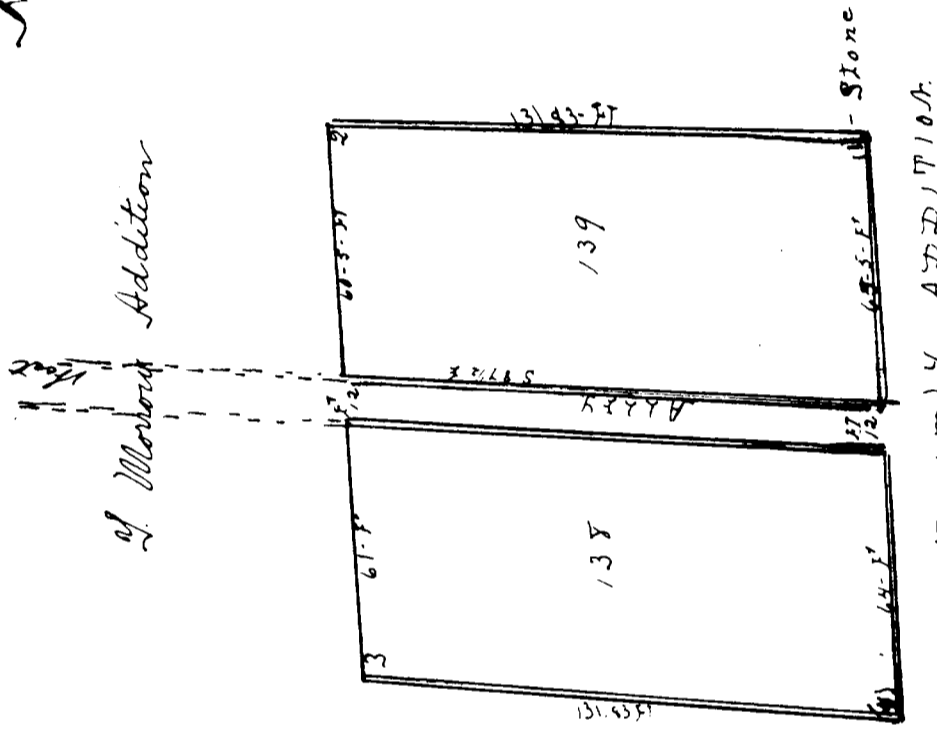

Corner of Daniel Sarno property (now the Gasworks) at a stone planted (marked) thence west 131 1/10 feet thence S 4 1/2 E - 133-5 feet thence S 86 1/2 E - 131 1/10 feet thence S 4 1/4 W - 140-5 feet to the place of beginning & containing 2 lots namely lots 138 & 139 of Aaron Plumly addition to the town of Cammerell each lot fronting on St. Chestnut St. No. 138 is eighty four (64) feet in front & 61 feet in rear, No. 139 is 65-5 feet in front & 61-5 feet in rear depth of each 131 1/10 feet alley 12 feet wide dividing the two lots as even in plat
