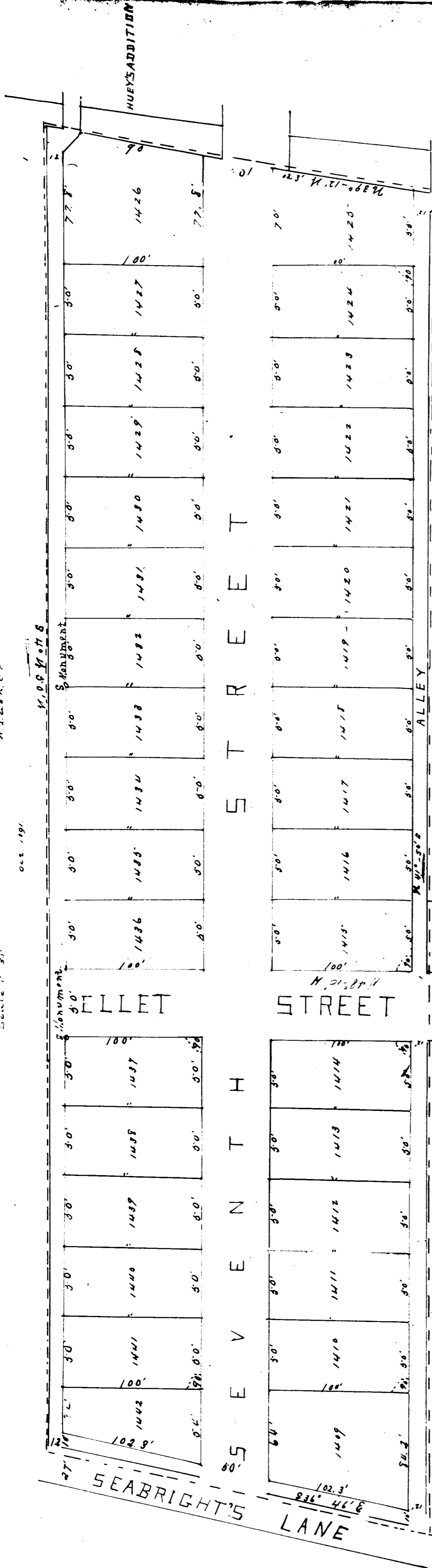


ELLET HEIR'S ADDITION TO MARTIN'S FERRY, OHIO.

The numbers, dimensions of lots, names and widths of the Streets and alleys are as shown upon the map. The delineation proper is enclosed by dotted lines and contains 5.93 Acres.

Two Iron measuring rods 80 inches long by 1 inch in diameter are placed as shown upon the map four feet from lot lines. Abraham Lash.
