

Proprietors First Addition to Bellair

State of Ohio Belmont County
S. G. Putnam of said County a very competent surveyor for that purpose as I believe do hereby certify that the above Map of the First Redifer Addition to the City of Bellair was made by me in accordance with an accurate survey of the premises also made by myself and that the same contained a particular and accurate description of the Streets Alleys Squares and fractional lots of said Addition showing by courses distances and monuments their boundaries and extent and of the Red border together with the numbers of the Squares and numbers of the lots into which the Squares are divided and the Streets and Alleys dividing or bounding the same. There being no Public grounds or lots I have designated the points on the above Map where the proprietor of said premises by my direction have planted and fixed good and sufficient stones pointed with iron from which to make future surveys two of them being placed four feet South 17°30' West (magnetic from the line of the North Side of Seventh Street one of the above being four feet North 12°30' West (magnetic course) from the line of the East of Noble Street and the other the same course and distance from the line of the East Side of Belmont Street and one on the South boundary line of said premises twelve feet South 88°44' 4" West (magnetic course) from the West side of Belmont Street
