 The Commissioners of Belmont County Ohio: we the undersigned the Mayor, Recorder and Trustees of the Incorporated Village of Barnesville, respectfully report that at the annual election held for office of said Village on the 2nd day of April A.D. 1866 the question of annexing the Territory hereinafter described was submitted to the qualified voters of said Village and of the votes cast there were one hundred and forty two votes for said annexation and one against the same. That the ordinance providing for the submission of the question of annexing territory as aforesaid to the voters of said Village was passed by the Committee of said Incorporated Village on the 20th day of February A.D. 1866 and your petition further represents that all of the west half of section (15) and all of the East half of Sec 21 also a lot belonging to Asa Gavettson and not belonging to John Bradford, and A. E. & J. M. Weaver, all of the above tract or territory being contiguous to and embody the Incorporated Village of Barnesville, as will more fully appear by the plat hereto attached. Your petition therefore respectfully prays that the limits of said Incorporated Village be so extended as to embrace the territory above described.
