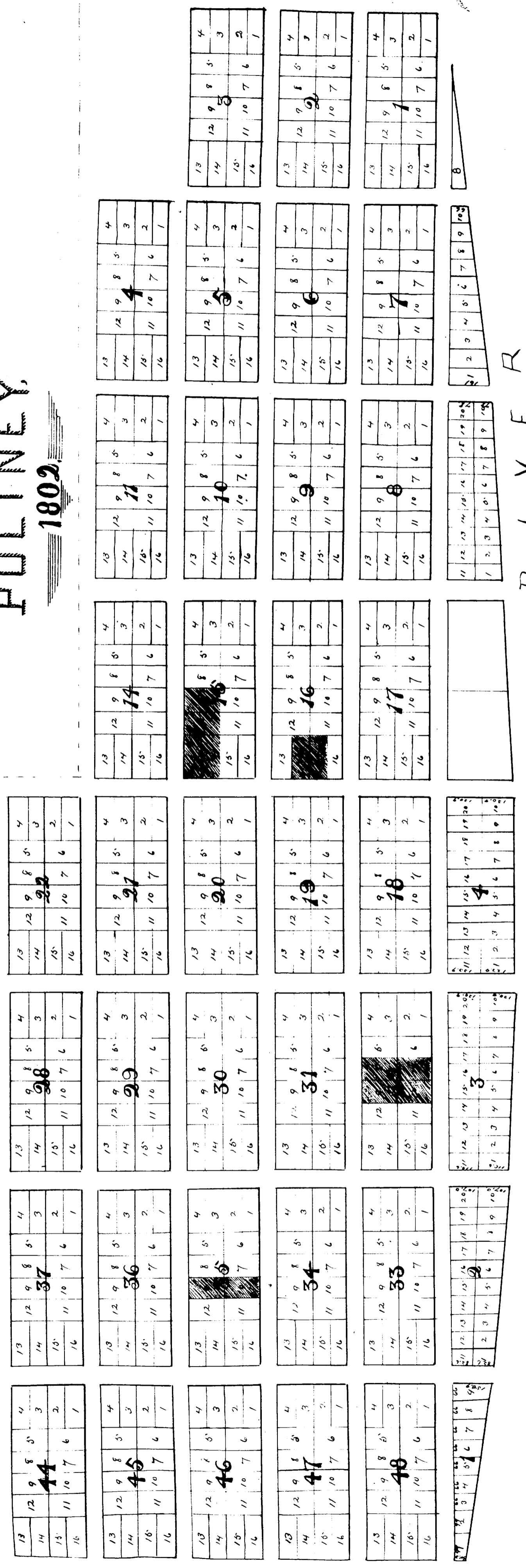


# PLAN OF FULTNEY, 1802



A plan of the Town of Fultney consisting of thirty five squares beginning on the Bank of the Ohio River and running N 84° W 27 Chains; thence N 6° E 75 Chains; thence S 84° E 75 Chains; thence S 84° E 11 Chains; thence S 84° E 16 1/2 Chains to the Bank of the Ohio River down the Bank with the several meanders thereof to the place of beginning. Each square is bounded by a Street of sixty six feet wide; the square is divided into sixteen lots each, and each lot contains one fourth of an Acre, the lots at the end of the square is sixty six feet in front and one hundred and sixty feet deep, the four central lots at the sides of each square is eighty two feet six inches in front and one hundred and thirty two in depth. The fractional squares lying along the River is divided into one hundred fractional lots fifty of them are donated lots for the first fifty Settlers coming with the Settlers of the Town.
