



Transcript of Proceedings Relative to the Annexation of Certain Territory to the City of Bellaire, Ohio.
 Whereas, by an ordinance of the City of Bellaire, Ohio, passed February 27th, A. D. 1906, and published according to law, which said ordinance is in words and figures following (except that the description of the territory annexed is to be found in the petition hereinafter mentioned), to-wit:
 "Ordinance No. 474" So authorizing annexation of certain territory to the City of Bellaire, Ohio. Be it ordained by the Council of the City of Bellaire, State of Ohio: Sec. 1. That the annexation of the following described territory, to-wit; (the description of which territory is found in said petition and here referred to and incorporated herein, as a part of this ordinance) to the City of Bellaire be and the same is hereby authorized. Sec. 2. That the Solicitor, E. C. Timberlake, be and he is hereby authorized to prosecute the proceedings necessary to effect such annexation. Sec. 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law. Passed February 27th, 1906. Charles Haesman, President of Council. Attest, J. H. Alther, Clerk of Council. Charles Stimpert, Mayor."

Therefore pursuant to said ordinance a petition was presented to the Commissioners of Belmont County, Ohio, an exact copy of which is included in the "Journal Entry" of said Commissioners, by said City of Bellaire, on June 4th, 1906, praying for the annexation of certain territory, which is fully described in the said petition, a map of which, as in said petition described, is thereto attached, and which said petition and map are here referred to and made the map and petition required by law to be a part of this transcript, the following being an exact copy of the Transcript of the Commissioners of said Belmont County, and containing said petition, as will more fully appear, reference being had to the Records of said Commissioners, Volume 9, beginning at page 275, to-wit;

Journal Entry St. Clairsville, Ohio, August 20th, 1906. Office of the County Commissioners of Belmont County, Ohio.
 Be it remembered That on the 4th day of June, A. D. 1906, at a regular session of said Commissioners, there was presented to said Commissioners of said Belmont County, Ohio a petition in words and figures as follows, to-wit:— "In the matter of the Petition of the City of Bellaire, Ohio for the annexation of Territory. So the Commissioners of Belmont County, Ohio: The City of Bellaire, Ohio respectfully represents that by an ordinance duly passed by its Council on the 27th day of February A. D. 1906, the following described territory, to-wit; Beginning for the same at low water mark on the west shore of the Ohio River where the south boundary line of Lot No. 1 in Rockershausen's Allotment would if projected eastwardly intersect said low water mark. Running thence with projected line and south line S. 81 Deg. 1 Min. N. 600 feet, more or less to the South west corner of said Lot No. 1; thence with the west boundary line of the said Rockershausen's Allotment N. 13 Deg. 25 Min. N. 644.5 ft. to the north west corner of Lot No. 20 in said Rockershausen's Allotment, the same point being in the south boundary line of Austin's addition to Bellaire; thence thencewith S. 71 Deg. 59 Min. N. 5.5 feet; thence with the east and north boundary line of Cliff Street in said Austin's Addition, as follows; N. 39 Deg. 42 Min. N. 361.5 feet; thence N. 89 Deg. 24 Min. N. 225 feet to the south west corner of Lot No. 23 in said Addition, the same point being in the west boundary line of the said Austin's Addition; thence S. 88 Deg. 19 Min. N. 752 feet to the south west corner of the Finch Run No. 3 School Lot; thence with the boundary line of same as follows; N. 43 Deg. 33 Min. N. 230.3 feet; thence N. 57 Min. E. 77 feet; thence N. 89 Deg. 27 Min. E. 98 feet; thence leaving said boundary line and running parallel with and 200 feet distant from said north boundary line of a 20 foot roadway in Austin's Allotment of Belmont, N. 15 Deg. 13 Min. N. 70 feet to a point 200 feet north of the north boundary line of a 20 foot roadway in Austin's Allotment of Belmont, N. 68 Deg. 47 Min. E. 837 feet to the corporation line of the City of Bellaire as it now exists; thence thencewith N. 15 Deg. 52 Min. 27 Sec. N. 3557.44 feet to the north boundary line of the lands of Therington, deceased; thence in the same course N. 15 Deg. 52 Min. 27 Sec. N. 103.5 feet; thence leaving said corporation line and
