 the petition contains a full description of said territory, that the map of said territory attached to the petition is accurate; that  
 the ordinance of said City of Sallairs authorizing said annexation was duly passed by the City of Sallairs, and published according  
 to law; that the required legal notice of the petition has been given by publication and by posting as required by law; and that  
 it is right and proper that said petition should be granted.

It is hereby ordered that the prayer of said petition be and the same is hereby granted, and that the territory described  
 in said petition may be annexed to the City of Sallairs, Ohio, in accordance with law, and that a certified transcript, signed by  
 a majority of this Board and all the orders and proceedings of this Board relative to said petition and hearing thereon, together  
 with said petition, and map attached thereto be deposited by noon with the Clerk of said City of Sallairs.
