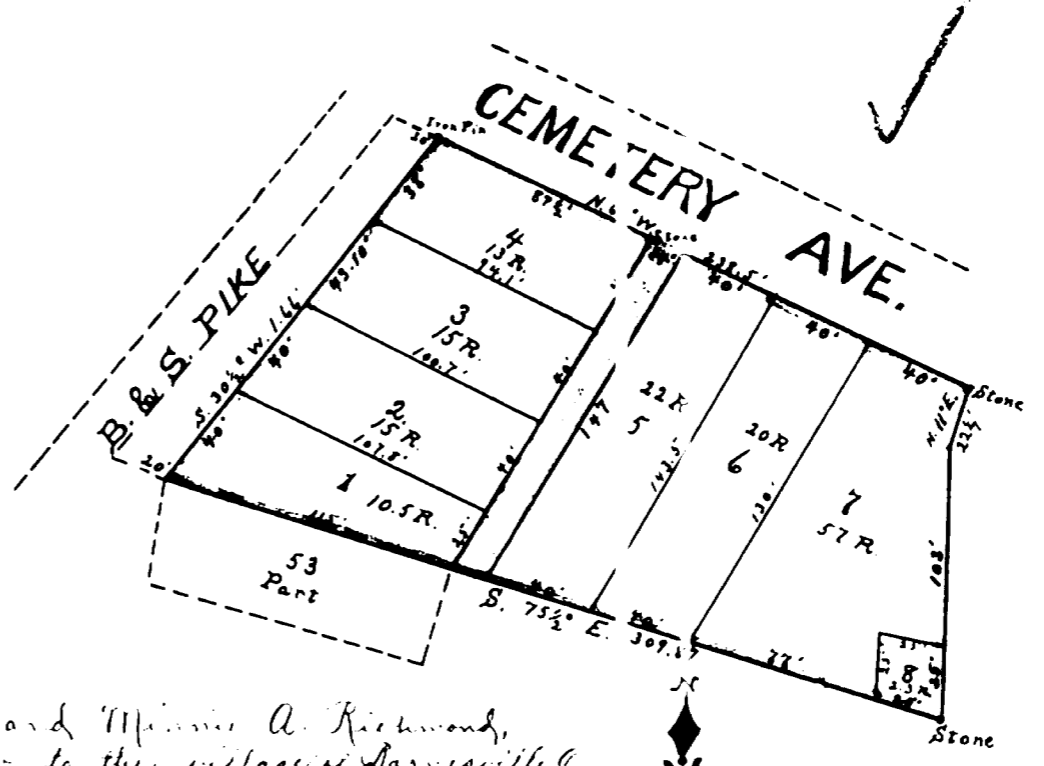


Richmonds Proposed Extension to Leggetts and Bishops Addition to Barnesville, Ohio.
