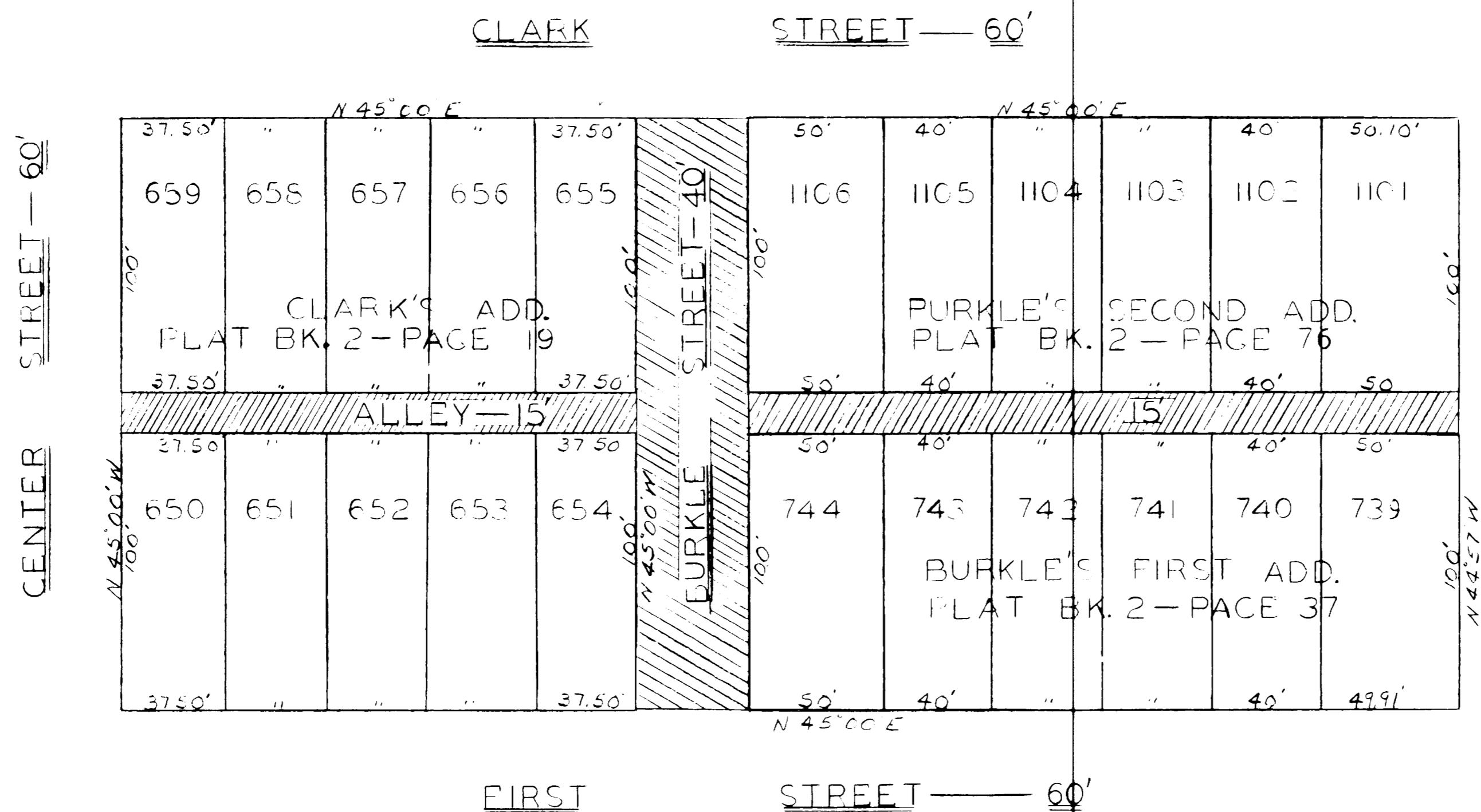
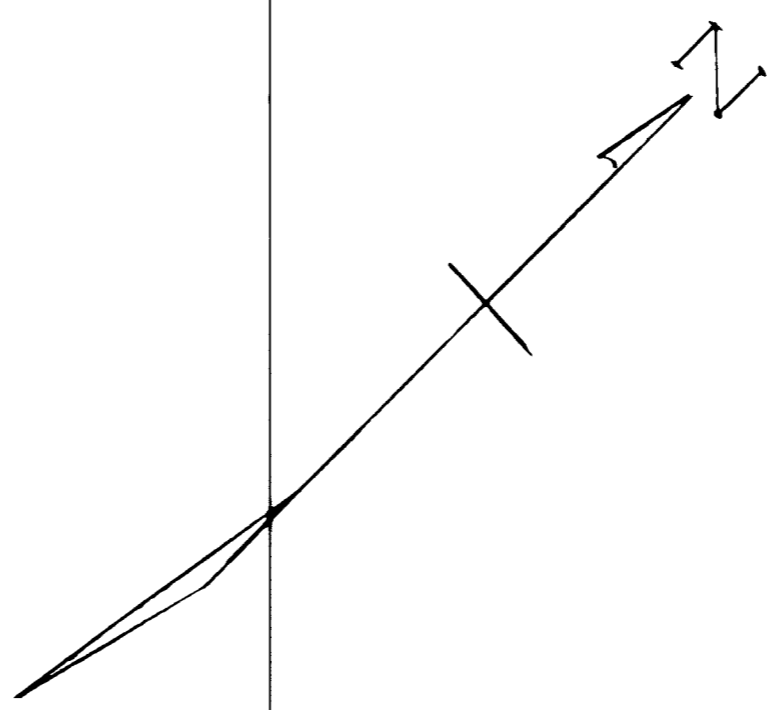

Ordinance No. 6341  
AN ORDINANCE VACATING BURKLE STREET AND AN ALLEY IN THE CITY OF MARTINS FERRY AND RECAPTURING AN EASEMENT  
WHEREAS, on June 21, 1973, a Petition was filed to vacate Burkle Street and an alley as hereinafter described; and  
WHEREAS, all the owners of the property abutting the part of the street and alley proposed to be vacated have filed therein their written consents to such vacation according and pursuant to law; and  
WHEREAS, this council is satisfied that there is good cause for vacating said street and alley as hereinafter described and that it will not be detrimental to the general interest and ought to be done;  
NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARTINS FERRY, COUNTY OF WOOD:  
SECTION I. That Burkle Street between the east line of Clark Street and the west line of First Street and the alley intersecting Burkle Street between the north side of West Street and the south side of Avondale Avenue as indicated on the map attached to the Petition, which Petition was on file in the office of the Clerk of the Council in a file bearing the same number as this ordinance, be and is hereby vacated.  
SECTION II. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the citizens of Martins Ferry, Ohio, and for the further reason that the lots owned by the petitioners, and the streets to be vacated, are immediately needed for sale for industrial expansion.  
SECTION III. That this ordinance shall take effect, and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
