

# INCORPORATION OF TOWN

## In The Matter of The Incorporation of Bethesda, Ohio. To the honorable Board of Commissioners of Belmont County, Ohio.

And now this 14th day of August 1911, I, J. C. Brown and C. J. Miller, the duly appointed agents of the petitioners herein, and ask leave of your Honorable Board to amend the original petition in this matter in this respect that the description of the territory proposed to be incorporated may be changed as hereafter set out, and that only said territory within the limits of the following described boundaries be included within said village, being as follows, to wit:

Known as and being parts of Sections 23 and 24, Township 7, and Range 5, Tenth Township, said County and State, and beginning for the same at a stone in the center of the north boundary line of Section 23, thence north 89° 30' east 111 feet to a stone; thence south 13° 30' east 1956.5 feet to an iron pin; thence south 43° 30' east 1192 feet to an iron wood bush; thence south 42° east 423 feet to a stake; thence south 89° 30' west 581 feet to a stake; thence south 72° east 760 feet to a post; thence south 89° 30' west 488 feet to a stake; thence south 74° east 423 feet to a stone; thence north 89° 30' west 110 feet to the south east corner of John Simpson's lot; thence south 42° east 505 feet; thence south 81° 33' west 544 feet to a telephone pole and of the same; thence south 37° west 283.75 feet to a stake; thence north 89° 30' west 894.5 feet to an iron pin on the south west corner of Harmon's Addition; thence north 72° west 908 feet to a stone; thence south 89° 30' west 933.5 feet to a stone; thence north 15° west 806 feet to a stake on the north side of the Baltimore and Ohio Railroad; thence north 66° east 118.75 feet to a stake at the south west corner of Hunt's First Addition; thence north 15° west 2579 feet to a stake on the north side of the county road leading from Barnesville to Bethesda; thence north 84° 30' east 158 feet to a stake; thence north nine hundred and forty six feet to a stake; thence north 84° 30' east seven hundred and seven feet to a post in John's line; thence north 27° west five hundred and forty two feet to a stone at the north west corner of John Pusey's land; thence north 72° west from hundred (300) feet to a stake; thence north 89° 30' east eight hundred sixty eight and one half (868.5) feet to a stake on the quarter section line; thence south 42° east from hundred (300) feet to a stone and the place of beginning, containing three hundred and eighty six and one hundredth (386.01) acre.

Said territory is hereby substituted for the territory described in the original petition, all other parts of said petition remain unchanged and are hereby adopted and made a part hereof as if recited within.

## In The Matter of The Incorporation of Bethesda. Before the Board of County Commissioners of Belmont County, Ohio.

Whereas on August 14, 1911, J. C. Brown, A. L. Crispen and C. J. Miller, the agents duly appointed and authorized to act in the above matter before the board of Commissioners relative to the organization of the territory in the petition described into a village, and whereas said agents believing it advisable to amend the petition and part in the above matter leaving out a small part of the lands of J. M. Hunt, A. F. Pitzer and J. H. Thwait, and not including territory outside that described in the original petition, leave was issued by the commissioners to make such amendment, making the territory as described in the amended petition as follows, to wit:
