Validation and Confirmation of Action of Equity of Petition in asking for have to Amend Original Petition for Incorporation, to be signed by signers of original petition only.

In The Matter of the Incorporation of Shadyside, Ohio:

Whereas, on the 16th day of January, A. D. 1911, J. C. Stovange and C. E. Simbartke, the duly appointed agents of the Petitioners herein, asked leave of the County Commissioners to amend the original petition in this matter, in this respect, to wit: that the description of the territory proposed to be incorporated may be changed as hereafter set out, and that only said territory be included within the limits of said Village, viz: Situated in the Township of Mead, County of Belmont and State of Ohio, to wit: Being a part of Sections Twenty-six (26), Twenty-seven (27), Twenty-eight (28) and Twenty-nine (29), respectively, all in Township Two of Range Two, Beginning for the same at the point where the Mead and Bulmy Township lines intersect the west shore of the Ohio River at low water mark; running thence with the said township line west four thousand four hundred and seventy (4470) feet to where the west boundary line of Rodger's Sixth Addition to Shadyside, projected northwardly would intersect said township line, thence with said west boundary line 5225.08 three thousand two hundred and seven (3227) feet to the south west corner of said Rodger's Sixth Addition; thence 5225.08 two thousand four hundred and thirty-eight (2438) feet to the north east corner of Charles Swartz's lot; thence 516' 20" one hundred and eighty (180) feet; thence 500' 33" two thousand and eight hundred and fifty (2855) feet with the south boundary line of the John St. Math farm and said line produced to the west shore of the Ohio River at low water mark; thence up said River at low water mark to the place of beginning. Which said territory is hereby substituted for the territory described in the original petition, all other parts of said petition remaining unchanged, and hereby adopted, and hereby adopted and made a part hereof as if herein written.

Whereas, leave to amend said original petition as prayed for above was then and there granted on said 16th day of January, A. D. 1911 by the said County Commissioners of Belmont County, Ohio, Now, Therefore, We the undersigned being duly sworn of the persons who signed the original petition, and all being residents within the above described territory, hereby ratify and confirm the action of our said Agents and ratify and confirm the action taken by said Commissioners in granting said leave to amend said original petition.
