Mr. C. Zimmerman, appearing for J. S. Bralton and others presented a petition asking that all property South of the north line of Heath and Mrs. Brunyild be not included in said incorporation. A counter-statement was also presented signed by 28 residents of Shadyside asking that the petition be not granted for the reason that the financial condition of the proposed corporation does not at present warrant such action.

The Board arranged to meet at Shadyside November 30th to view the premises.

And now upon this 16th day January, A. D. 1911, this cause coming on to be further heard and considered, there was filed with the said Commissioners a request for leave to amend said petition, which said request was in the words and figures following:

In the Matter of the Incorporation of Shadyside, Ohio:

To the Honorable Commissioners of Belmont County, Ohio:

And now on this 16th day of January, A. D. 1911, come C. Harbaugh and C. E. Timberlake the duly appointed agents of the petitioners herein and ask leave of your honorable body to amend the original petition in this matter, in this respect, to-wit; that the description of the territory proposed to be incorporated may be changed as hereafter set out, and that only said territory be included within the limits of the said village, viz: Situated in the Township of Wood County of Belmont and State of Ohio, to-wit: Being a part of Sections Twenty-six (26), Twenty-seven (27), Thirty-two (32) and Thirty-three (33) respectively, all in Township two and range two. Beginning for the same at the point where the Shad and Fulton Township line intersects the west shore of the Ohio river at the low water mark, running thence with the said township line west four thousand four hundred and seventy (4470) feet to where the west boundary line of Rodgers Sixth addition to Shadyside, projected northwardly, would intersect said township line, thence with said west boundary line S 22° 08' W two thousand two hundred and seventy (2270) feet to the south west corner of said Rodgers Sixth addition, thence 22° 24' W two thousand four hundred and thirty eight (2438) feet to the north west corner of Cleve Macers lot, thence S 16° 20' E one hundred and eighty (180) feet, thence 66° 30' E two thousand eight hundred and fifty (2850) feet with the south boundary line of the John Malth farm and said line produced to the west shore of the Ohio river at low water mark, thence up said river at low water mark to the place of beginning.*
