An ordinance accepting and confirming the dedication of a part of Summit Street in Martin's addition to the Village of Bethesda, Ohio.

 That the dedication to public use for street purposes from Spring Street to the corner of James Knox property and intersecting Summit Street, and to be known as such street, surveyed and platted by David C. Kennon, Civil Engineer, and dedicated to public use by the Commercial Savings Bank be and the same is hereby accepted and confirmed under said dedication.
